


Block 3 151/2" x 181/2" unfinished

#### Cutting

#### House

1–11½" x 2¼" rectangle

1-9" x 31/4" rectangle

2-6" squares

1-21/2" x 31/2" rectangle

1-2" x 3½" rectangle

1-2" x 21/2" rectangle

#### House Roof

1-8½" square cut in half once on the diagonal to make 2 half-square triangles

#### **Mailbox Front**

1-21/2" x 41/4" rectangle

1-1½ circle

#### Mailbox Side and Pole

1-3" x 31/4" rectangle

1-1" x 2" rectangle

#### Mailbox Roof

1-11/4" square

1-1½" square

1-2" x 11/2" rectangle

#### Windows

1-31/2" square

1-2" x 3½" rectangle

1-134" x 21/2" rectangle

#### Flag

1-21/2" x 11/2" rectangle

#### Background

1-151/2" x 2" rectangle






#### Construction

Use 1/4" seams. Press in the direction of the arrows in the diagrams.

### House Roof

(A) Join one 8½" roof and one 8½" background half-square triangle to make one half-triangle square (HTS). Make 2. Trim to 8".






Roof HTS 8" x 8" unfinished Make 2.



(B) Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 2–6" house squares. Layer a marked house square, right sides to together, on a roof HTS as shown. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim the 6" house square only, ¼" from the diagonal line. Press to reveal the triangle. Make 2. Join to make the house roof.



#### **M**ailbox


Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 1–1½" background and 1–1½" mailbox roof squares. Layer a marked background square, right sides to together, on the 2½" x 4½" mailbox front as shown. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim ½" from the diagonal line. Press to reveal the triangle. Repeat using the marked 1½" mailbox square on the opposite corner as shown. Appliqué the circle to the front. Add a 2½" x 4½" background rectangle as shown.






Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of  $1-1\frac{1}{4}$ " mailbox roof square. Layer the marked square, right sides to together, on the  $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " window as shown. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the diagonal line. Press to reveal the triangle.

Follow the steps to assemble the mailbox flag and house windows.










Mailbox Flag and House Windows 11½" x 3½" unfinished
